THE BENEFIT SHARING PROJECT

Deliverables:

Central working document, proposing operational and actionable solutions, around 3 major sections:

- legal analysis of the space and lunar activities benefit sharing context: OST and relevant frameworks
- inventory (taxonomy) of benefit sharing practical implementations from the ground up.
- review of the current space domain governance process centered around the UN (COPUOS, UNOOSA).
- Other deliverables if appropriate - targeting UNOOSA, private sector, investors, civil society



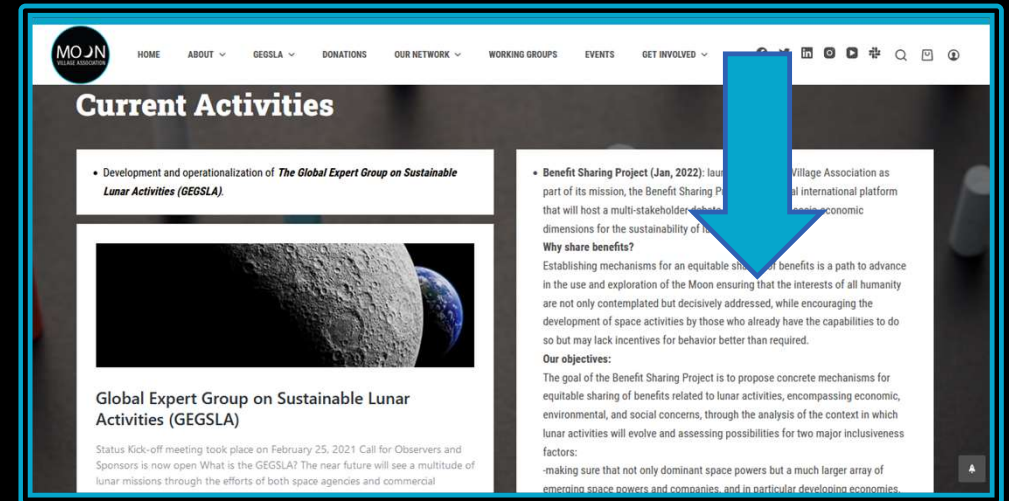
THE BENEFIT SHARING PROJECT
